

High Profile Tray Series INSTRUCTION MANUAL





- 1. When you receive your Newline shower check contents for any freight damage.
- 2. Advise Newline on 0508 639 5463 if any damage has occurred or a defect identified within 8 hours of receiving the goods so this can be rectified.
- 3. Do not proceed with installation until resolved.



DOOR SET / IMPORTANT INFORMATION

WARRANTY

Faulty goods are covered under warranty. Visit www.newline.co.nz for warranty information. Breakages incurred during construction are not covered under warranty. Installations must conform to the instructions to be covered by the warranty.

HEALTH AND SAFETY

Toughened Glass:

- Do not rework precut glass panels. Cutting or altering a glass panel will cause it to explode without warning.
- Unpack all glass assemblies. Stand glass on soft packaging on the floor and against a wall. Care must be taken not to strike any edge or corner against a hard surface as this will chip and destroy the glass panel.

Installation:

- Glass panels and assemblies are heavy. Two man lifting is recommended for handling and installation.
- Determine positioning of wiring and piping within wall cavities before shower installation. Mark their positions to ensure electrical and piping areas are avoided.
- Wear appropriate protective clothing and eye protection during installation.

AFTERCARE

Newline recommend squeegeeing down the glass after every shower and cleaned weekly with a microfiber cloth, mild detergent and water. Rinse with clean water and squeegee and wipe dry.

DOOR SET / IMPORTANT INFORMATION

PREPARATION CHECKLIST

ENSURE YOU TICK THE SPECIFIC BOXES THAT APPLY AS YOU PROGRESS

2 Sided Shower: Ensure the floor is level and the walls are plumb and flat.
Position all framing for solid fixing for the shower tray, shower and plumbing fittings. Wall profiles require a stud flush with the tray outside edge.
Ensure all plumbing items have been installed prior to the lining being attached.
Alcove Shower: Critical that the walls are constructed plumb and flat. Request the specific width of the Acrylic Tray prior to framing.


ACRYLIC TRAY AND LINER OPTION

- Detailed installation instructions are packed with the shower tray for tray and lining installation.
- Alcove application will require specific detailing of framing and is based on 10mm plasterboard lining.
- Shower waste and supply fittings must be installed by a registered plumber.



Page 9 to 14 3-Sided Alcove Shower








SHOWER TYPE	WALL CHANNEL ADJUSTMENT
900mm Return Panel	870mm (minimum) to 888mm (maximum)
1200mm Door	1165mm (minimum) to 1185mm (maximum)


Walls out of plumb will not allow for full minimum/maximum options.

LAYOUT DETAILS
High Profile Acrylic Shower
Tray size 1200 x 900 x 75mm high
Position the channel at 13mm
off tray edge on both sides. This
allows for walls bowed or leaning
inwards up to 4mm. Reduce the
measurement off tray edge if floor
and walls dictate this.









Fit return panel.











Door parts and seals





Adjust shower inwall profiles and square up door. Drill and fasten door frame to wall profile.


Apply silicone to join as indicated.









Allow 24 hours for silicone to dry before use.







COMPONENT LIST: DOOR SET 3-SIDED ALCOVE




SHOWER TYPE	WALL CHANNEL ADJUSTMENT
1200mm	1155mm (minimum) to 1185mm (maximum)














Fasten wall profiles.



Silicone bead on back of wall channels prior to installation.








Door Installation







